Performance Objectives: By the end of the lesson, the students would be able to;

1. Define the two and three-dimensional art works.
2. Name the two and three dimensional arts.

4. Mention objects in their environment that have two or three dimensions.

(A) What is dimension? Dimension refers to the measurement of objects bearing in mind their length, width & depth.

(B) Therefore What is Two dimensional works of art? The two dimensional works of art are those art works which are done on flat surfaces only. They have the dimensions of width and length only.

Examples of two dimensional art works are: (1) Drawing (2) Painting (3) Graphics (4) Textile designing (5) All designs that are done on paper.

(C) What is three dimensional works of art? Three dimensional works of art are all art works that have length, width and depth/ thickness/height.

NOTE: In three dimensional works, we bear in mind volume, mass, form and shape. Examples of three dimensional works of art are (1) Sculpture (2) Ceramics (3) Architecture (4) Modeling (5) Construction (6) Carving (7) Casting.

(D) The Differences between two and three dimensional works of art

(1) The two dimensional art works have only length and width while the three dimensional art works have length, width and depth.

(2) The two dimensional art works are done on flat surfaces only while the three dimensional works of art are done on shapes that have thickness e.g wood, clay, stone,

iron etc.

(3) The two dimensional art works are seen or viewed from only one side, that is; from front alone while the three dimensional art works have an all pleasing view, that is; they are observed from all sides.

(2) Answer all the questions in Your work book that deal on two dimensional and three dimensional art works(Design).
